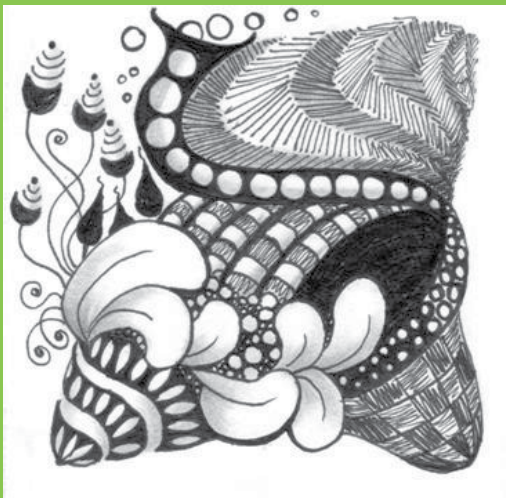

This course requires the completion of 16 units and is delivered over a 6 month period with one day a week in the classroom, one day a week of home study plus work placement activities.
